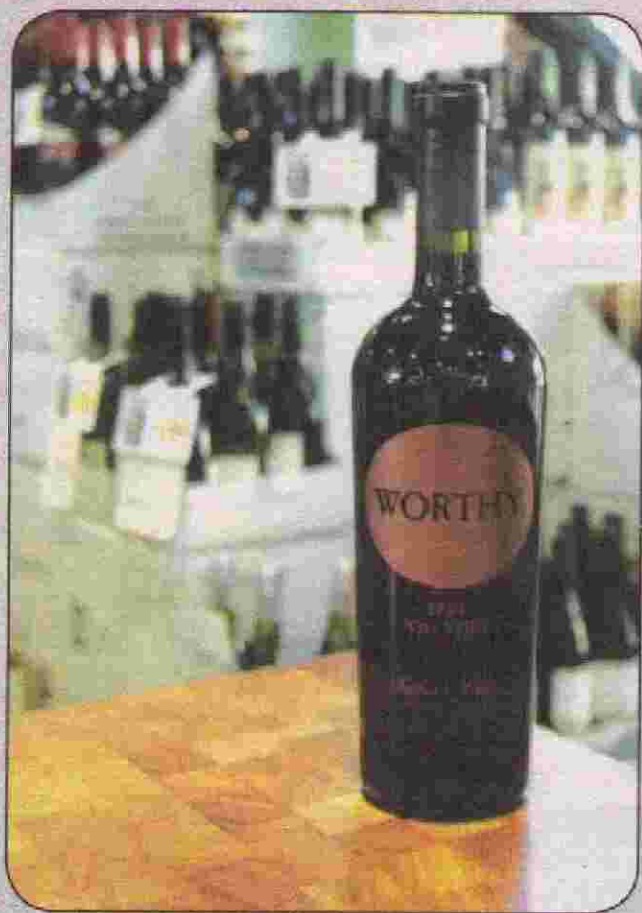


Wine Time
